We continue in our search for mystery readers...

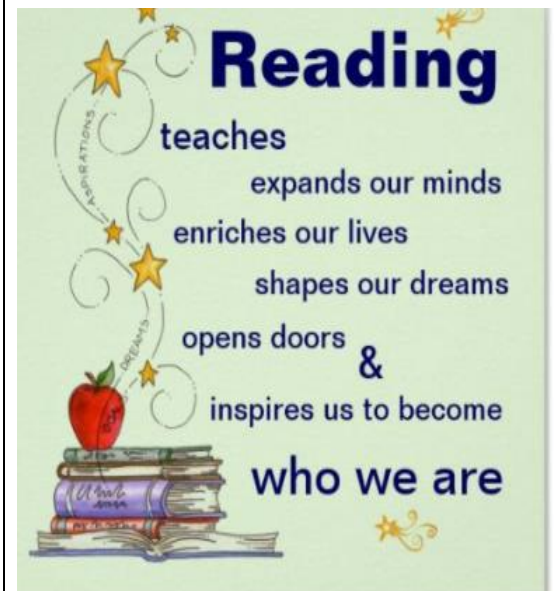
Would you like to come and read a story to the Romans or Vikings? Please see your child's teacher to arrange a date. **Shh!** It's a surprise for both your child and their class!
