#### Welcome to The Abbey primary School...

This is an exciting term supporting your children with settling into the new rules and routines of school and encouraging them to make new friends and feel confident in their class. Our Community code teaches children about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school. #### How I can help my child at home.

##### **Supporting at home...**

**Storytime** - Never underestimate the importance of reading to your children. Every bedtime story you share develops your child's vocabulary and enhances their imagination.

**Reading** - A phonic book or sentence sheet, a story and a reading record book will be sent home with your child as the term progresses. We ask that you read at least three times a week and that you to sign and or comment in the record.

**Phonics** - Your children will be coming home with sound sheets so that you can help support your child to recall the sounds we are learning in school. We encourage the children to recognise the letter sound only. Encourage your child to think of words that begin with the sounds by playing 'I spy' type games.

**Do please see you child's class teacher if you would like help or advice with any aspect of your child's learning.**
