History – Dynamic Dynasties

In History, the children will learn about periods of ancient Chinese history. They will explore a timeline of the first five Chinese dynasties. They will look into the history of the Bronze Age Shang Dynasty and explore evidence found in the ancient city of Yin.

Science - Forces and machanisms

In Science, the children will learn about the forces of gravity, air resistance, water resistance and friction, with children exploring their effects. They learn about mechanisms, their uses and how they allow a smaller effort to have a greater effect.

Geography - Investigating our world

In Geography, the children will learn to use ordanance survey maps and six figure grid references. They'll also learn about time zones, climate zones and vegetation belts.

History - Maafa

In History, the children will learn about Ancient African Kingdoms, the development of the transatlantic slave trade, Britain's role in the slave trade and the causes and consequences of the abolition of the slave trade and slavery.

Science - Circulatory system

In Science, the children will learn about the transport role of the human circulatory system, its main parts and their primary functions. They learn about healthy lifestyle choices and the effects of harmful substances on the body.

Geography - Maafa

In Geography, the children will learn about Africa – the countries which make up Africa, settlements, population, climate and physical features.

Art - Trailblazers, barrier breakers

In Art, the children will learn about significant black artists and their work. They will have opportunities to analyse and create artwork inspired by them.

Activities which support this: Partitioning numbers, adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers and practising times table recall to support multiplication and division methods.
