History – Emperors and Empires

In History, the children will learn about the history and structure of ancient Rome and the Roman Empire, including a detailed exploration of the Romanisation of Britain.

<u> History – Ancient Civilisations</u>

In History, the children will learn about the history of three of the world's first ancient civilisations: ancient Sumer, ancient Egypt and the Indus Valley civilisation. Children will learn about the rise, life, achievements and eventual end of each civilisation.

Art - Beautiful Botanicals

In Art, the children will learn about the genre of botanical art. They will create natural weavings, two-colour prints and beautiful and detailed botanical paintings of fruit.

<u>Art – Statues, Statuettes and Figurines</u>

In Art, the children will learn about the 3-D representation of the human form, including statues, statuettes and figurines. They study examples from ancient civilisations, and use their clay skills to create a Sumer-style figurine.

Science - Plant Nutrition and Reproduction

In Science, the children will learn about the requirements of plants for growth and survival. They describe the parts of flowering plants and relate structure to function.

<u>Science – Electrical Circuits and</u> conductors

In Science, the children will learn about bout electrical appliances and safety. They will construct simple series circuits and name their parts and functions, investigate electrical conductors and insulators and identify common features of conductors
