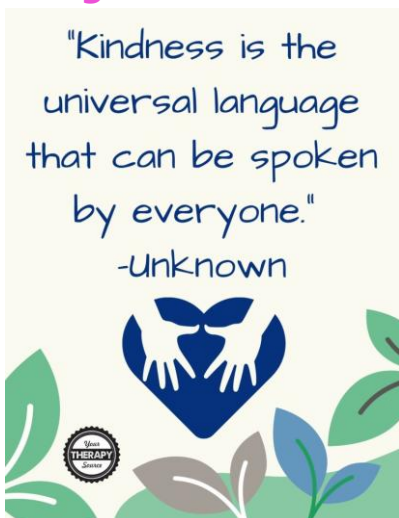

<p>History – Through the ages In History, the children will learn about British prehistory from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including changes to people and lifestyle caused by ingenuity, invention and technological advancement.</p>	<p>History - Invasion In History, the children will learn about life in Britain after the Roman withdrawal. Children will learn about Anglo-Saxon and Viking invasions up to the Norman conquest.</p>
<p>Art – Prehistoric pots In Art, the children will learn about Bell Beaker pottery. It allows the children to explore different clay techniques, which they use to make and decorate a Bell Beaker-style pot.</p>	<p>Science – Sound In Science, the children will learn about sound, how sound is made and how sound travels as vibrations through a medium to the ear. They will learn about pitch and volume and find out how both can be changed.</p>
<p>Geography – One Planet, Our World In Geography, the children will learn to locate countries and cities, and use grid references, compass points and latitude and longitude. They will learn about the layers of the Earth and plate tectonics and discover the five major climate zones. They will learn about significant places in the United Kingdom and carry out fieldwork to discover how land is used in the locality.</p>	<p>Geography – Interconnected World In Science, the children will learn about compass points and four and six-figure grid references. They learn about the tropics and the countries, climates and culture of North and South America. Children will identify physical features in the United Kingdom and learn about the National Rail and canal networks. They will conduct an enquiry to prove a hypothesis, gathering data from maps and surveys before drawing conclusions.</p>
	<p>Art – Warp and Weft In Art, the children will learn about the artform of weaving and how it has developed over time, including the materials and techniques required to create woven patterns and products.</p>

Activities which support this: adding and subtracting 3 and 4 digit numbers, the use of Times Table Rock Stars to learn multiplication and division facts.

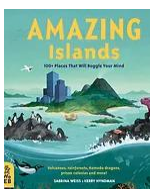
English
