Supporting at home...

Storytime - Never underestimate the importance of reading to your children. Every bedtime story you share, develops your child's vocabulary and enhances their imagination.

Maths

In Term 1, Nursery will learn about colour, patterns and shapes. Activities which support this: talk about different colours and patterns recognising similarities and differences

In term 1, Reception will learn numbers to 5, recognise numerals and identify small groups by sight. Activities which support this: talk about how many objects they can see, practise recognising numbers in the environment and counting objects.

Reading

In Term 1, Nursery will practise listening skills and identify different sounds in the environment and sounds words begin with. Activities which support this: singing songs and rhymes, listening for sounds in the environment. Talk about pictures in books.

In Term 1, Reception will begin to learn letter sounds and to blend these sounds by saying them aloud together. Complete sound sheets sent home and follow the QR code videos for each sound.
