Remote Learning has had a positive impact with 97% accessing google classroom and 'live' lessons. Following PiXL Implications for Teaching Report (Dec 2020) shows that Girls Maths was a concern. Girls will become a key focus in lessons and identified girls are in B1 Maths groups for intervention. PP children in Year 2 are receiving Interventions for B1 Reading, Phonics, S & L, Thrive, B1 Maths, Play therapy and Lego therapy. Reading and Maths will have B1 groups led by part-time Booster teachers for English and Maths. Due to Lockdown this started on 8th March 2021. Due to one teacher shielding A2 Maths groups will start on 12th April 2021. NTP -We have identified GPS and Reading for PP children in Year 5, we anticipate this will start in April 2021. From April 2021, additional teacher to support Power Maths lessons for both Year 5 classes as Maths identified as an issue from December 2020 data. With recent Lockdown we need to ensure Maths strategies have been embedded.
