This Term...

Year 3 Curriculum

Geography – Rocks, relics and rumbles

In geography, the children will learn about the features and characteristics of Earth's layers, including a detailed exploration of volcanic, tectonic and seismic activity. They will learn about the causes and consequences of different natural disasters and be able to identify different types of rocks by their properties.

Art – People and Places

In art, children will learn about the genre of figure drawing. They study the figure drawings and urban landscapes of the artist LS Lowry and create artwork in his style to show scenes from their school.

DT- Making It Move

In DT, the children will learn about cam mechanisms. They will experiment with different shaped cams before designing, making and evaluating a child's automaton toy.

Year 4 Curriculum

Geography – Misty Mountain, Winding River

In geography, the children will learn about the characteristics and features of rivers and mountain ranges around the world, including a detailed exploration of the ecosystems and processes that shape them and the land around them. Children will study the human and physical geography of a region of the United Kingdom, a European country, and a region within North or South America.

Science – Grouping and classifying

In science the children will learn about grouping living things, known as classification. They study the animal and plant kingdoms and use and create classification keys to identify living things.

DT – Functional and Fancy Fabrics

In DT, the children will learn about home furnishings and the significant designer William Morris. They learn techniques for decorating fabric, including block printing, hemming and embroidery and use them to design and make a fabric sample.

Encourage children to measure the length of a range of items in cms and metres. Split everyday objects into a range of groups and have children work out what fraction it represents.
