Year 3 Curriculum

History – Emperors and Empires

In History, the children will learn about the history and structure of ancient Rome and the Roman Empire, including a detailed exploration of the Romanisation of Britain.

Science – Light and Shadows

In Science, the children will learn about light and dark. They will investigate the phenomena of reflections and shadows, looking for patterns in collected data. The risks associated with the Sun are also explored.

DT – Greenhouse

In DT, children will learn about the purpose, structure and design features of greenhouses, and compares the work of two significant greenhouse designers. They will learn techniques to strengthen structures and use tools safely to design and construct a mini greenhouse.

Year 4 Curriculum

History – Ancient Civilisations

In History, the children will learn about the history of three of the world's first ancient civilisations: ancient Sumer, ancient Egypt and the Indus Valley civilisation. Children will learn about the rise, life, achievements and eventual end of each civilisation.

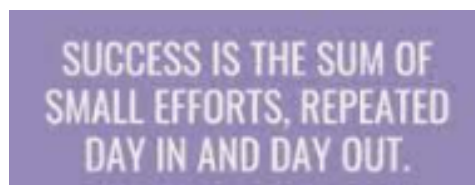
Art – Islamic Art

In Art, the children will learn about the features of Islamic art. They will make geometric patterns and motifs on paper, with fabric and in clay. They will use create a high relief clay tile, decorated with geometric patterns.

DT – Tomb Builders

In DT, the children will learn about simple machines, including wheels, axles, inclined planes, pulleys and levers, exploring how they helped ancient builders to lift and move heavy loads.

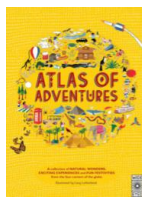
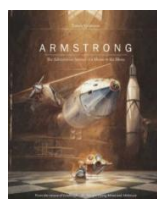
English
